

Zach White's Garden Plants and Flowers

The majority of the plants I sell are annual flowers. I am at the Jasper Farmers Market during the two main planting seasons; spring and fall.

Spring

Various colored Begonias, Impatiens, Salvia and other annuals
Specialty annuals such as Angelonia or summer snapdragons, Mandevilla Vines, and Petunias
Specialty plants such as Elephant Ears, and various grasses
Vegetable and herb plants; tomatoes, peppers, Rosemary and other herbs.

Fall

Various colored pansies such as Majestic Giant Mixed, orange, purple, yellow with blotch. Dusty Miller, snapdragons and other Fall/Winter/Spring flowers
Perennials such as grasses, Hens and Chicks, Russian Sage Kale, Parsley, Rosemary and other herbs and other various plants.

I will be at the Market in the spring from the week of April 15th to the last week in June or when I sell out and then will return for a week or two in September and will be there every Saturday in October after the marble festival.
